With the introduction of Measure 37, Oregon land use laws became more complicated to understand than ever before. Measure 37 opened the door to allow land holders the potential of developing their land as they would have been able when they bought their property. However, state bureaucracy, litigation and special interest groups have made what seemed to be a straight forward law into a complicated process filled with pitfalls. Many land owners are asking "What are my options right now?" And they are finding out that although current law provides new options for land owners, and these new rights have been incorporated into Oregon law, they are being challenged daily by special interest groups and even our own Oregon Legislature and Governor. There are over 7000 Measure 37 claims filed by long-term Oregonians, most of who have owned and worked the land which their claims exist for over 30 years. They are good, hard-working people who may not be getting fair treatment regarding their claims.
